Excursion to Warnham Local Nature Reserve & Millpond, Horsham

18-August-2018. Warnham Local Nature Reserve (10:00 ~ 16:00).

Please note the location is on the NW of Horsham town and **NOT** Warnham Village.

Quekett Members are invited to a day at Warnham Local Nature Reserve to investigate the microscopical flora and fauna of this Local Nature Reserve, hosted by the Friends of Warnham Local Nature Reserve, with kind permission of the Wardens.

Warnham Mill Pond was originally created as part of the Sussex iron working industry, but more recently provided the water for a mill to grind grain. The mill survives intact (but not open to the public) and the surrounding land comprises Warnham Local Nature Reserve.

The mill pond is fed by two streams, Boldings Brook and Chennels Brook, and there are three small ponds used for pond dipping. Two board walks give access to wetlands and woodland.

The Wardens have granted permission for the day to collect samples for microscopical inspection from the public access areas of the Reserve. Please do not stray from these areas. Please also ensure that collecting equipment is clean, as the Wardens wish to avoid contamination from other sites.

Attendance is free, but please ensure you are signed in at the Visitors' Centre.

Snacks, tea, coffee etc. are available from the Herons' Rest Café at the Visitors' Centre. There is also a nearby shop and a pub, The Dog and Bacon, just down the road.

Tea, coffee and biscuits will be free for signed-in attendees.


