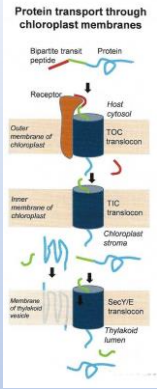


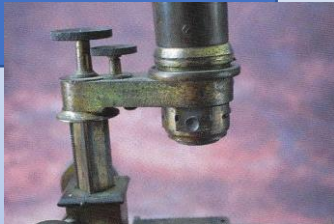


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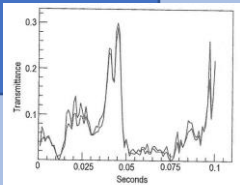
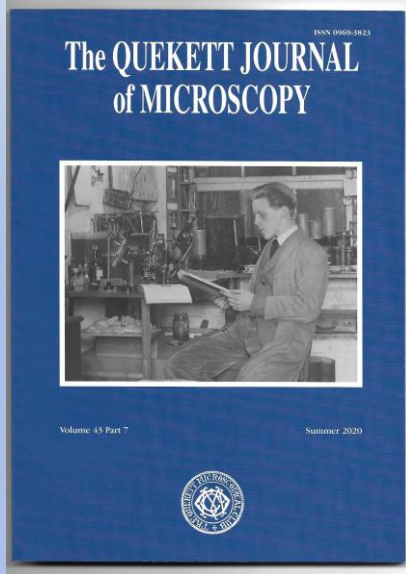
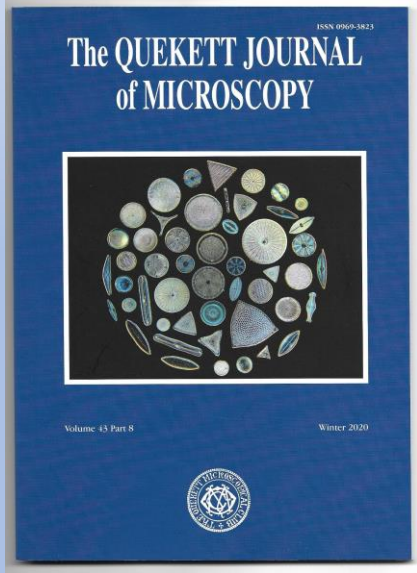
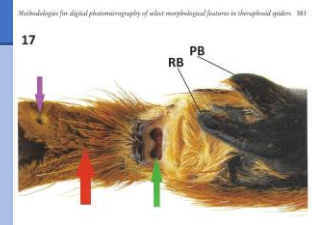
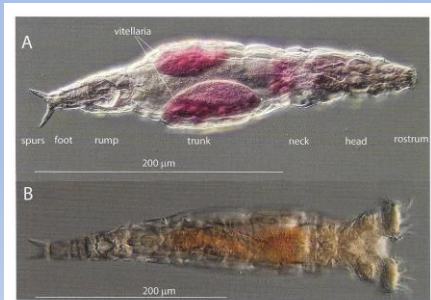
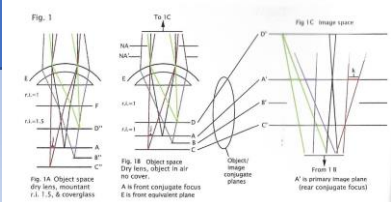


FIG. 6. Both recording chappels at 700 nm, responding in the same way to a flicker pattern on the turbulent water surface caused by bubbles and lenses.
